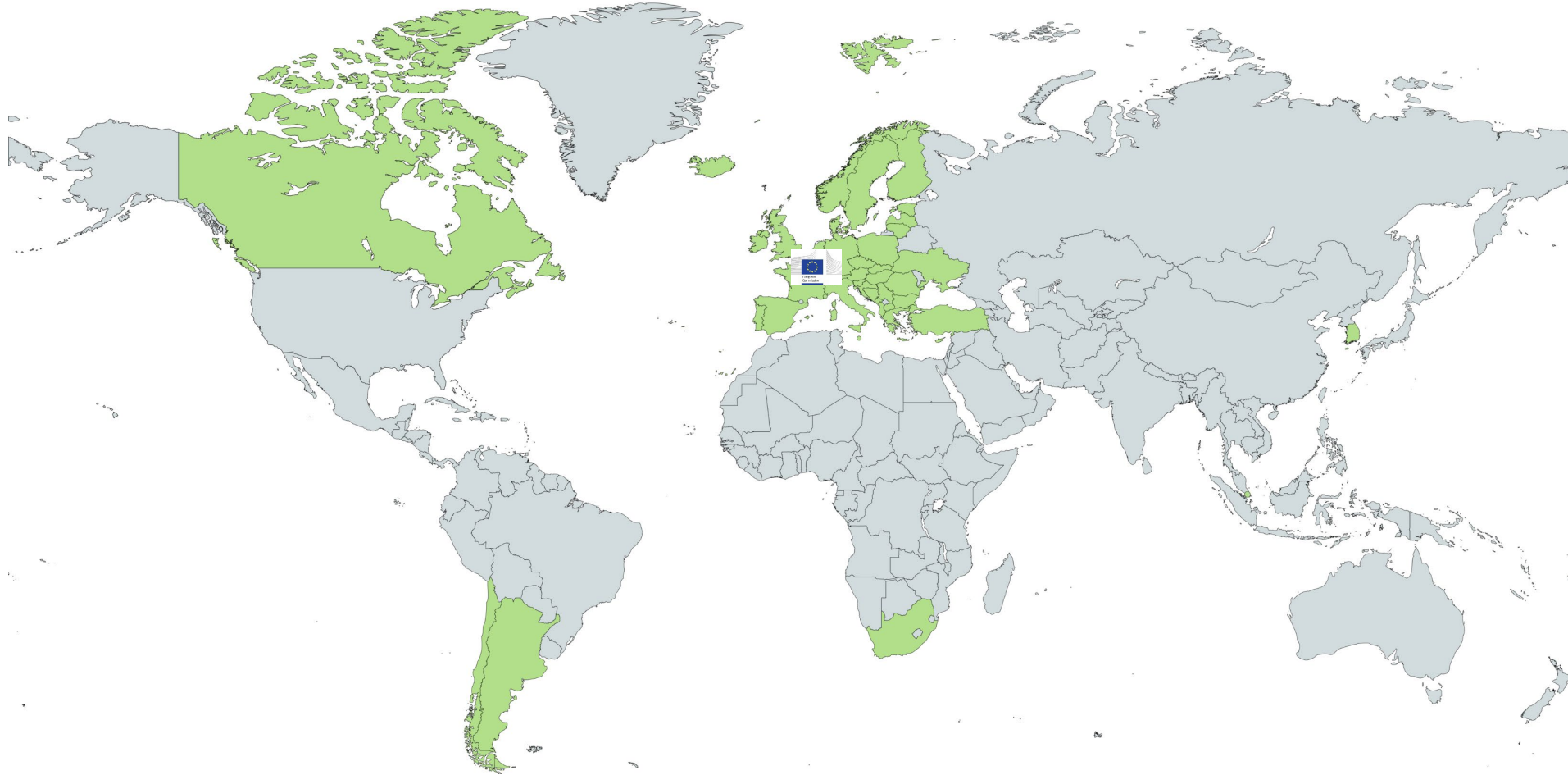
Eureka History

Founded in **1985** by prominent European political figures, Eureka is one of the longest running organisations dedicated to **funding international R&D projects**.

Eureka was established with the **Paris Declaration** on 17 July 1985, and its principles are based on the **Hannover Declaration**, signed by ministers on 6 November 1985.

Founding 18 countries in 1985 were Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, The Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Türkiye, United Kingdom and the European Union.

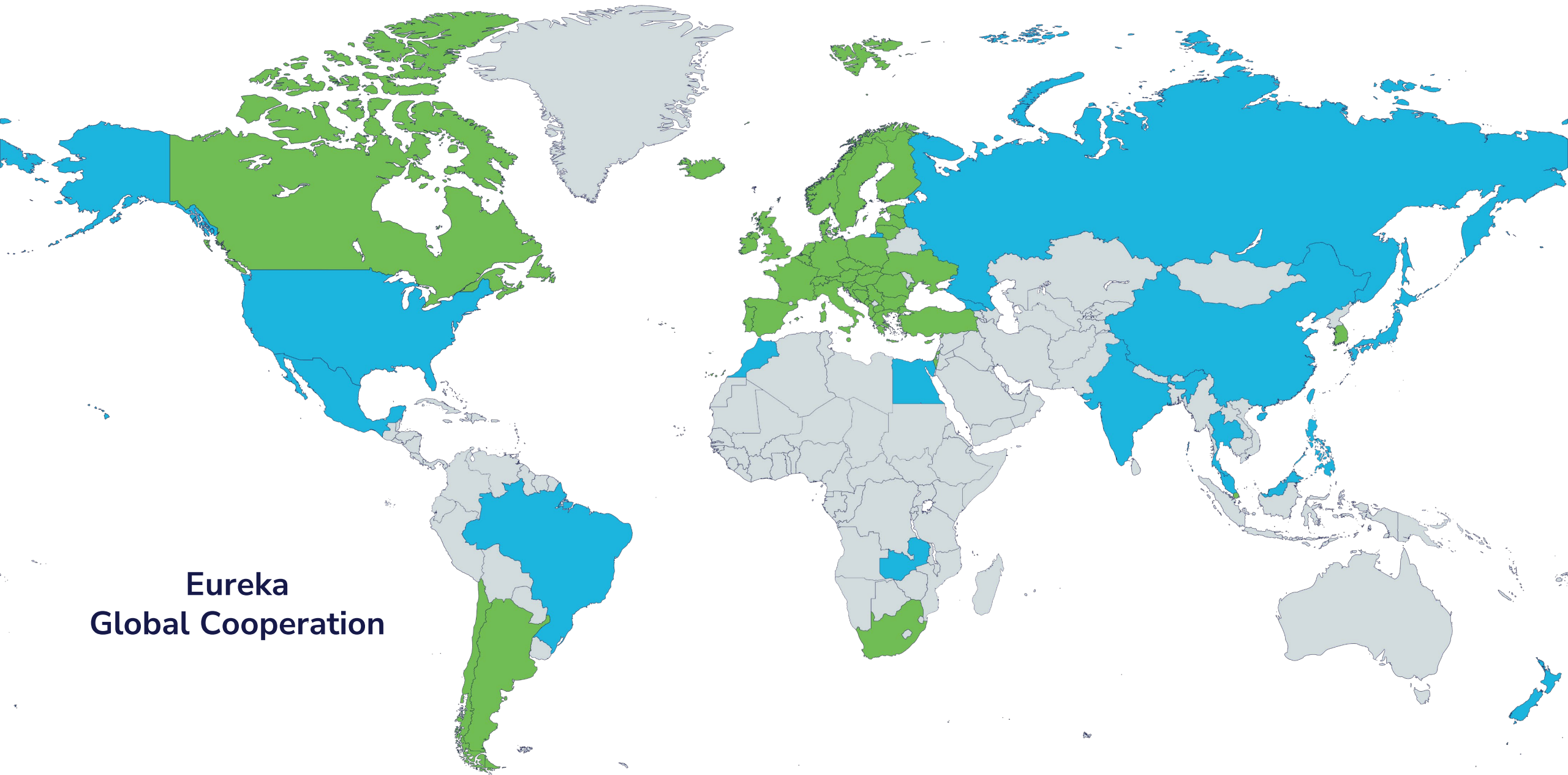




The Eureka network: from 18 countries in 1985 to 47 today - plus the European Commission

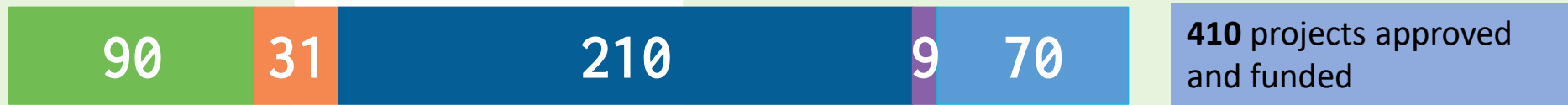

 - please note national recommendations

Countries involved

- **Albania, Austria, France, Hungary, Montenegro, Serbia and Türkiye**
- Your project consortium must include organisations from the countries listed
- **AND must include at least one partner from Albania, Montenegro or Serbia**
- In addition to those partners, partners from other Eureka countries or countries outside of Eureka's network can also participate, provided their public funding or self-funding is secured within the call for projects deadlines.

Please note:

- ...if required by your national funding body, project participants must also submit a **national funding application**, considering all relevant national procedures, deadlines and application rules
- ...70:30 Rule: no country (no organization) to have more than 70% of total budget (smart simple)
- ...national application deadlines might be different than May 15, 2024
- ...we suggest to contact Eureka NPC in your country before preparing Eureka applications
- ...if you are looking for a partner – please register to the B2match website for this call, contact your Eureka NPC, or contact EEN in your country

Eureka evaluation criteria - Partner search / matchmaking

Call procedure & recommendations

- Talk to your national contact point as soon as possible
- (Optional) Use the b2match partner search tool
- Register into the Eureka smartsimple IT platform
- By **15 May 2024 at 17:00 (CEST Brussels Time)** - Submit your project application through the Eureka IT platform
- Submit your national application (**national deadlines could be different**)
- The application will be checked for completeness and eligibility
- The application will be evaluated at International level and National evaluations could also take place
- Projects above threshold will get the Eureka label. Funding will depend on the national decisions. Signed CA must be done by the consortium.

Call evaluation criteria

○ Impact (market)

- Is the market properly addressed (i.e. size, access and risks)?
- Is the value creation properly addressed (i.e. employment opportunities and environmental and societal benefits)?
- What are the competitive advantages of your project (i.e. strategic importance, enhanced capabilities and visibility)?
- Are your commercialisation plans clear and realistic (i.e. return on investment, geographical and sectoral impact)?

○ Excellence (technology)

- What is the degree of innovation? (i.e. is the proposed product, process or service state-of-the-art?)
- Is there sufficient technological maturity and risk?
- How is the new knowledge going to be used?
- Is your project scientifically and technically challenging for consortium partners?
- Is the technical achievability and risk properly addressed?

○ Quality and efficiency of implementation (consortium)

- What is the quality of your consortium (i.e. balance of the partnership and technological, managerial and financial capabilities of each partner)?
- Is there added value through international cooperation?
- Is your project management and planning realistic and clearly defined (i.e. methodology, planning approach, milestones and deliverables)?
- Is your cost structure reasonable (i.e. costs and financial commitment for each consortium partner)?

○ Overall perception

Call evaluation scores & threshold

Impact – Market and Commercialisation	30 out of 60 (minimum threshold: 50%)
Excellence – Innovation and R&D	30 out of 60 (minimum threshold: 50%)
Quality and Efficiency of Implementation – Project Planning and Consortium Quality	30 out of 60 (minimum threshold: 50%)
Minimum average threshold score: 108 out of 180 (60%)



Important information

Each project consortium must nominate a **main partner organisation** and have **at least one other partner organization from another country.**

ONE application form per project consortium:

- Only the main partner creates an application
- The other partners must be invited by the main partner

Tips

For main partner...

- Save draft regularly
- Fill in as much information as possible and define the work package structure before inviting partners
- Make sure your partners' email addresses are correctly spelled in the invitations

Before you submit your application:

- Check the 'OVERVIEW' section (some information is automatically filled in from complete partner forms) → **Is any partner missing? Is the project duration correct? Is the budget correct?**
- Check the application form pdf

- Eureka projects can be submitted for funding to the General Programme (Basisprogramm) of FFG which provides the Eureka funding scheme illustrated below.

 - please note the download center at the bottom with all the relevant guidelines for this Call
- Project applications must be submitted online via FFG eCall: <https://ecall.ffg.at>
- The deadline for the national application is the same as for the Eureka application
 - evaluation follows the national cut-off dates (<https://www.ffg.at/content/basisprogramm-f-rdersitzungen-und-beirat>): decision at board meeting approx. 24. Oktober 2024
- Joining a project on self-funded basis is possible, you are required to contact the Eureka NPC at FFG.

Specific National Rules

- Open-topic projects in the area of "Experimental Development" (Technology Readiness Level 5-7)
- General-Programm (Basisprogramme) Project:
 - Objective: Promotion of product, process and service developments (R&D project).
 - An economically feasible R&D project with a high degree of innovation (technological novelty) and corresponding degree of difficulty (technological development risk) and high exploitation potential (market prospects).

Eligible costs and funding rates

- All companies registered in Austria are eligible for funding, universities and research centers can be funded as subcontractors only.
- The evaluation of the Austrian project part is carried out by internal experts at FFG. The project must fulfil the national criteria.
- There is no dedicated budget for this call. Funding in Austria is provided on an annual basis only, therefore follow-on applications must be submitted for the max. duration of 3 years.
- General Programme provides grants for Austrian SMEs participating in Eureka projects:
 - Up to 60% of the eligible costs for small companies
 - Up to 50% of the eligible costs for medium-sized companies
 - Up to 40% of the eligible costs for large companies

Additional documents required

- National full project proposal
 - In addition to the Eureka application, the Austrian participant has to submit a separate national full project proposal to FFG General Programme (Basisprogramm) via eCall.

Tips for the submission

- Before submitting the international application, please read the application documents and guidelines of the General Programmes
- Address the questions outlined in the project description
- Avoid copy and paste from the international Eureka application
- Please clearly indicate the Eureka cooperation and upload the international application ("Eureka Westbalkan 2023 Project title")

Main responsibilities in EU international programmes

Support for Hungarian participation in the Eureka Programme

- A special support programme co-finances the Hungarian Eureka project participants, including cluster and network project participants
- The call is financed from the National Research, Development and Innovation Fund to support Hungarian participation in the Eureka programme
- The goal is to facilitate the involvement of entrepreneurs - in particular small- and medium-sized enterprises - in international research and development cooperation

Support for Hungarian participation in Eureka (Preliminary Information)

- The Hungarian Eureka Call 2024 will be launched in Q2 2024 with two cut-off dates (Q3 and Q4 2024) (PRELIMINARY INFORMATION)
- The evaluation, labelling and selection of funding procedure lasts 4 months with the involvement of independent technical and economic experts
- The application is accepted also in case of Eureka project proposals and not only with endorsed projects, however the contracts will be concluded with the National Research, Development and Innovation Office as Funding Agency only if the project gets the Eureka label
- In the support programme application of SMEs, large companies, universities and research institutions are accepted - the publicly funded institutions need an industrial partner in order to be eligible



Funding

- Hungarian Eureka Programme budget is 500 million HUF (approx. 1,4 M EUR) in 2024
- This amount is available for the Hungarian applicants in all the Eureka cluster and network project activities
- Max. funding amount per project is 70 million HUF (approx. 190 000 EUR)



Eligibility criteria

- The participation of for-profit companies (large enterprises, SMEs) is mandatory
- Participation of universities and research institutions are accepted, but publicly funded institutions need an industrial partner in order to be eligible.
- Eligible costs are salaries, equipment costs (amortization), external development services, travel costs, other development costs etc. (cluster fee included!)



Rates of funding

- Micro and small enterprises 80% (60% for experimental development)
- Medium-sized enterprises 75% (50% for experimental development)
- Large enterprises 65% (40% for experimental development)
- Universities and RTOs 100%



National submission process

- Hungarian participants must submit a separate national full proposal via the Electronic Portal for Proposals, Information and Communication (EPTK)
- The evaluation of the Hungarian project part is carried out by external experts
- The projects must fulfill all national criteria published in the Hungarian Eureka Call
- Participants are invited to contact the NPCs before submitting the documents in order to check the eligibility of the project idea and consortium

Specific National Rules - Requirements

- Eligible for funding: companies (SMEs, large companies) and scientific research institutions registered in Montenegro (same conditions for all applicants)
- The entity whose project is accepted for co-financing must be registered in the Register of Innovation Activity at latest prior to the signing of the Contract with the Ministry

Specific national rules - Eligible costs

- Fees of persons engaged to work on innovative project
- Material costs (medium and small equipment, raw material, etc.);
- Development services or development costs;
- Participation on relevant events (registration fees, transportation costs, per diem and accommodation); and
- Administrative costs and overheads

Specific national rules - *De minimis aid regime*

- The support granted to entities engaged in economic activity, regardless of their legal status and way in which they are financed, will be provided under the de minimis aid regime (state aid of small value)
- Statement on de minimis aid must be submitted to the Ministry prior to the conclusion of the Contract on co-financing Eureka project.

 3. Ranking list created and published (Ministry website)

- Criteria in line with Eureka methodology (EUREKA Network project Review Guidelines)
- Technological and economic assessment of the project proposal referring to four groups of criteria:
 - ✓ Impact - Market and Commercialization
 - ✓ Excellence - Innovation and R&D
 - ✓ Quality and efficiency of the implementation - Project planning and consortium quality
 - ✓ Overall Perception

- Eligible for funding is consortia of the Serbian industrial and the research partners
- Universities and scientific institutes are beneficiaries of the public fund
- Companies cover their own project costs



Specific National Rules - Requirements

- The Serbian applicant in the international consortium can also be a coordinator of the Eureka network project or a partner
- All participating organizations from Serbia must be signatories to the Consortium Agreement
- The result of the project is expected in the new or significantly improved product, technology or service
- Implementation of the results on the market must be visible up to 2 years after the end date of the Eureka project
- The organizations implementing the project must finance at least 50% of the costs on the projects realization from own funds or clearly marked sources of funding



Specific National Rules - Application procedure

- Rules, application procedure, national evaluation criteria, funding of endorsed projects, monitoring and projects reports are defined by the Act for funding of the Eureka projects

Funding rates

- Max 50% of total project costs
- Maximal amount per project of 150.000 €
- Project duration is up to 36 months



Eligible costs

- Direct costs of the Eureka project must be necessary for the realization of the project and in accordance with the principles of financial management, especially in terms of the obtained value for the invested amount and the economic justification of the realized investment
- Must be made by projects participants during the contracted period of the project implementation
- Must be recorded on the accounts or tax documentation of the projects participants
- Should be subject to identification and verification, and be supported by the originals of the corresponding accompanying documents



Eligible costs

- Personnel costs
- Travel costs
- Material costs: equipment, consumables ...development costs
- Costs of organization and participation/exhibition at events and fairs - promotion of the projects results
- Costs of intellectual property protection

Evaluation

- Duration 3-6 months
- Formal 2-step evaluation:

- Technological and economic assessment of the project proposal which refer to four groups of criteria from the aspect of the partner and project level:
 - ✓ basic criteria for evaluating suitability
 - ✓ key criteria of financial and contracted capacities of all partners
 - ✓ technological and innovative criteria
 - ✓ market and competitiveness criteria

Timeline	Turkish applicants must complete the national application by the 3rd of July, 2024. There is no any limit for the Project duration. However the international call time restriction is applied
Budget	Open budget. There is no budget restriction in National Programme but restriction defined in International call is applied
Specific National rules	All companies which were established in accordance with Turkish law can apply for funding for their international projects. Only companies participating in international projects are funded within this program, universities and research centers can be funded as subcontractors but they can not be participants of Project. Programme receives applications whole year however the application time line of the international call is applied.
Eligible costs and funding rates	Companies receive a certain percentage of their eligible costs as a grant. The percentage is 60% for large companies and 75% for SMEs.
