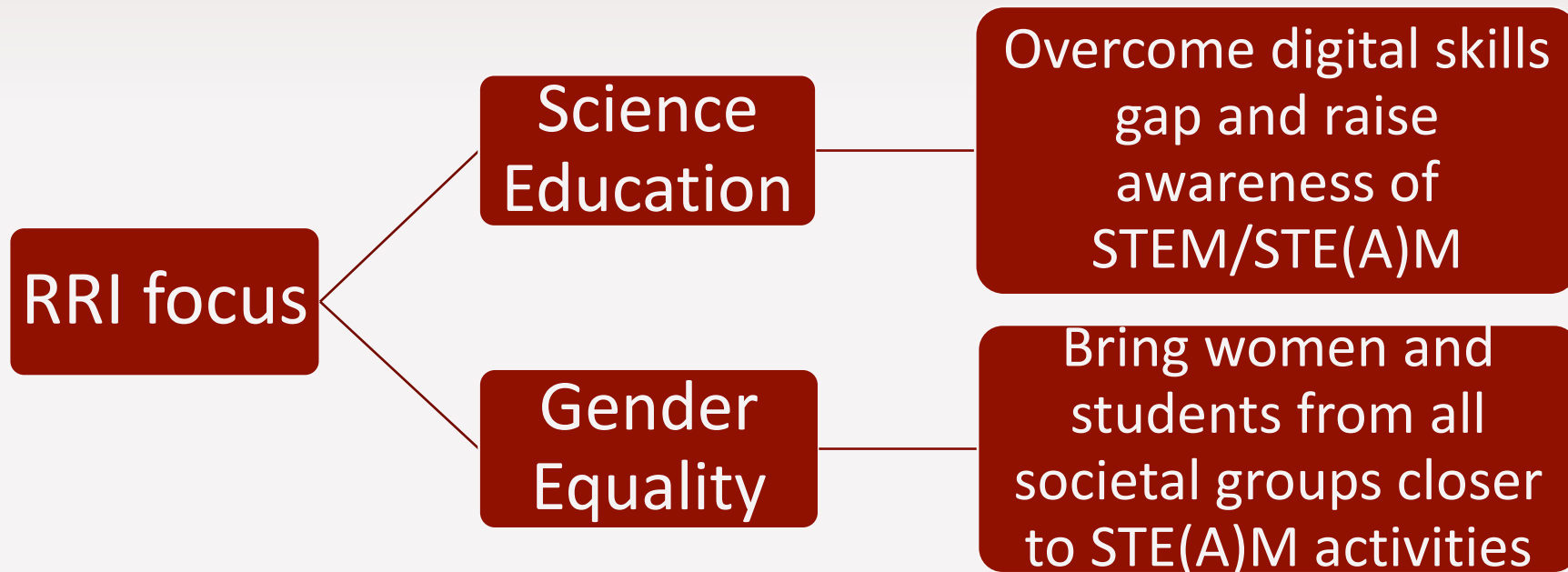

Current impact of activities:

- Increasing awareness regarding the need for science education and women in STEM, at networking events and engagement with QH for national/regional strategies development
- Workshops, competitions and trainings discussing the benefits of STE(A)M disciplines inclusion in secondary and higher education
- Survey exploring students, teachers and parents' perceptions of science education and gender equality in the Macedonian education system
- Capacity building activities and discussions to bring female students closer to ICT, and highlight the role of educators in raising awareness and motivating female representation in STEM careers
- Motivate actors to take an active participation - great interest by students and scientific community, lower by governmental institutions



Expected future impact of activities:

- What are your expectations for the future based on the realised anchor activities?
- What are the next steps?
- Collaboration between QH actors as a foundation for synergy with broader developmental goals and regional progress
- Evidence-based approach ensures impactful initiatives adapted to the community's needs and perceptions

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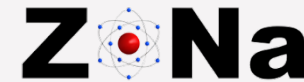
