# 11/04/2024: 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Socratic Dialogue Event: "A sea of cooperation. Towards a cohesive Euro Mediterranean research community"

Aim: sharing information and reflections on the perspective of developing and strengthening future collaboration of Mediterranean countries in the ERA, for joint R&I in agri-food and bioeconomy remit, in a spirit of open dialogue and mutual learning.

Target participants: funders and researchers from Mediterranean countries

### 12/04/2024: Workshop "Widening to Western Balkan countries"

Aim: exploring how stronger R&I collaboration with WB countries in the areas covered by HE Cluster 6 "Food, Bioeconomy, Natural Resources, Agriculture and Environment" can be achieved; discussing opportunities and challenges with concrete examples

Target participants: funders and researchers from Western Balkan countries



## **Emerging elements**

#### Issues debated

- Diversity of national conditions (internal as well as in terms of cooperation in the ERA), but with some similarities
- European research community perceived with high standards and advancing quickly. It seems difficult to "jump on the train".
- There is cooperation among ministries in the WBs on CAP and AKIS, less on research.
- Positive role of BIOEAST highlighted by some countries.
- Dialogue is crucial to attract institutions and funders' interest. Mobility and capacity building must be supported.

#### **Challenges for the WB countries:**

- ✓ low integration in the international cooperation networks
- ✓ lack of national funding, overall institutional support
- ✓ need to adapt/adopt the required legislation
- ✓ strengthening the AKIS (RIs, facilities, support to young researchers, etc.)
- ✓ involvement of the private sector



### Recommendations

- 1. In WB often **ministries of agriculture** do not support science/research as their focus is on technical issues of producers. **Ministries of science** are the best target group, although they support science in general, not only agriculture.
- 2. Option to establish **regional-level initiatives** for CEECs and WBs. Discussion on the possibility to have a Partnership, or an Art. 185, specifically targeted for a certain macroregion.
  - ✓ EC replied: general preference for thematic rather than geographically bounded <u>partnerships</u>, encouraging inclusiveness and representativeness for them. But a discussion started.
- 3. Suggestions to trigger engagement of national funders:
  - ✓ Address knowledge gaps with clear **information about advantages** for the ministries/countries expected in case of involvement.
  - ✓ Address "monetary challenges" that prevent some countries from being part of the EU calls.
  - ✓ Explaining the "virtual common pot" procedure, for which budgets committed by a national funder will fund only research groups from the same country.



### **Action points**

- Orgnise other events for widening, including policy makers, to keep them informed and convinced on the importance of international networking and joint R&I funding and to explain/clarify Partnerships' procedures, to improve capacity to engage with EU partners.
- 2. Interpersonal contacts already established under GEH can already be used to facilitate participation in joint calls and other activities already in the coming months.
- 3. The researchers present at the workshops can also act as **ambassadors** of these opportunities to their ministries and national funding agencies, telling the respective Ministries what they learnt.
- 4. It could be worth producing formal "letters of support" to enable contacts with hierarchies' regarding future R&I networks and calls.
