

Western Balkan's Participation in Horizon Europe

- Projects Awarded: 48 projects (204 eligible proposals)
- EU Budget awarded: EUR 9 million euros
- Number of participations by WB Organisations: 79
- 64 Distinct WB organisations
- Success Rate: 23,5% (above average)
- Mobility Flow: slightly unbalanced (140 WB researchers benefiting from MSCA vs. 98 researchers going to WB organisations)
- Gender Balance: 43.9% Female and 56.1% Male



Western Balkan's Participation in Horizon Europe

- Successful proposals: 48 out of 204 (23,5% success rate):
 - Doctoral Networks: 13 (incl. 4 Industrial Networks and 1 Joint doctorate)
 - Post-Doctoral Fellowships: 5 projects
 - Staff Exchanges: 23 projects
 - COFUND: 0 Project
 - MSCA & citizens: 7 projects
- 57,4% of the participating organisations are from the academic sector and 42,6% from the non-academic sector



Recommendations/Opportunities

- Encourage Western Balkan organisations to *participate more in postdoctoral fellowships (+ ERA fellowships) and COFUND actions*.
- Promote Western Balkan institutions as an attractive destination for foreign researchers (not only returning WB researchers)
- Support and empower the Western Balkan MSCA NCPs giving them the time, the means and the tools to perform their job efficiently.
- Take benefit from the strong partnerships developed under other EU programmes and cooperations with other EU networks
