OPEN CALL FOR COMMUNITY-LED ACTIONS TO RESTORE DANUBE-BLACK SEA REGIONS

WHAT IS SOS2LEARNDBS?

The **SoS2LearnDBS** project is part of the **EU Horizon Europe** program and aims to restore aquatic ecosystems across the Danube River Basin and Black Sea region. This funding call supports community-driven solutions that address pollution, habitat restoration, and promote sustainable blue economy practices.

The call has a total available budget of €7 million and aims to support grassroots initiatives that can demonstrate lasting impact on local environmental and societal challenges.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?



Consortia of 3-7 independent legal entities.

Partners must be established in EU Member States or Horizon Europe Associated Countries.

At least **one partner** represents or is directly accountable to **local communities** (e.g. local NGO, community organisation, municipality).

The consortium leader must be based in a Danube-Black Sea country:

Germany, Austria, Slovakia, Hungary, Croatia, Romania, Bulgaria, Slovenia, Czech Republic, Poland, Italy, Serbia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Ukraine, Moldova, Georgia, Türkiye or Albania.



WHERE CAN THE PROJECTS BE IMPLEMENTED?

Projects must be implemented in one of the five target regions:

- Upper Danube
 Lower Danube
 Black Sea
- Middle Danube
 Danube Delta

The call aims to fund at **least 2 projects per region** (minimum 10 projects overall).

WHAT SHOULD MY PROJECT BE ABOUT?

PROJECTS MUST

- Be community-led pilot actions lasting 18–30 months.
- Address local or regional challenges in the Danube–Black Sea basin.
- Contribute to at least one objective of the EU Mission "Restore our Ocean and Waters by 2030" and at least one of its targets:
 - Protect and restore marine and freshwater ecosystems and biodiversity.
 - Prevent and eliminate pollution of ocean, seas and waters.
 - Make the sustainable blue economy carbon-neutral and circular.

FUNDING RATE

LUMP SUM – PAYMENTS LINKED TO COMPLETION OF PREDEFINED WORK PACKAGES, NOT DETAILED COST REIMBURSEMENT.

TYPE OF GRANT

PERSONNEL, TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATION, EQUIPMENT (DEPRECIATION), OTHER GOODS/WORKS/SERVICES (E.G. MATERIALS, COMMUNICATION, EVENTS), SUBCONTRACTING (MAX. 30% OF REQUESTED GRANT), PLUS 25% FLAT-RATE INDIRECT COSTS.

HOW SHOULD I APPLY?

STEP 1

READ THE OPEN CALL DOCUMENTATION

Download and carefully read all documents available on the SoS2LearnDBS website for the Call for Proposals & Guidelines for Applicants:

- Budget template

STEP 2

PREPARE YOUR APPLICATION

Prepare your application using the <u>Online Application Form</u>.

Make sure you <u>answer all questions</u> and <u>upload all relevant documents</u>.

All parts must be completed in English and aligned with the guidelines.

STEP 3

SUBMIT YOUR PROPOSAL

Submit only via the **EU Survey** link above before **30 March 2026, 17:00 CET.**Multiple proposals are allowed, but each beneficiary can only be funded once.

After submission you should receive a confirmation email, if not, contact the SoS2LearnDBS team immediately.
