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The aim of Re-Engage is to

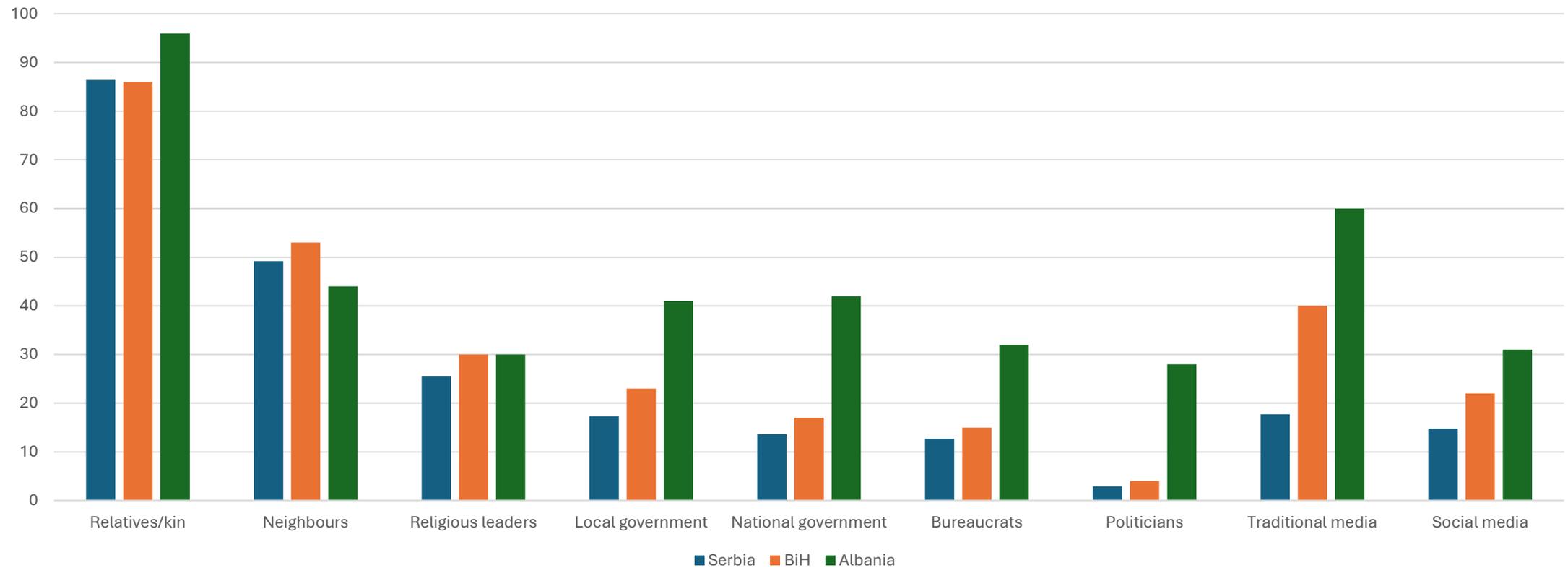
- Analyze how EU democracy support has worked and is working in a situation of war and increased geopolitical tensions where hybrid threats intensifies
- Our working assumption is that hybrid threats are hard to prevent, but societal resilience is possible
- Vertical and horizontal trust is key
- What's the situation in the Western Balkans?

# Collaboration & Methodology

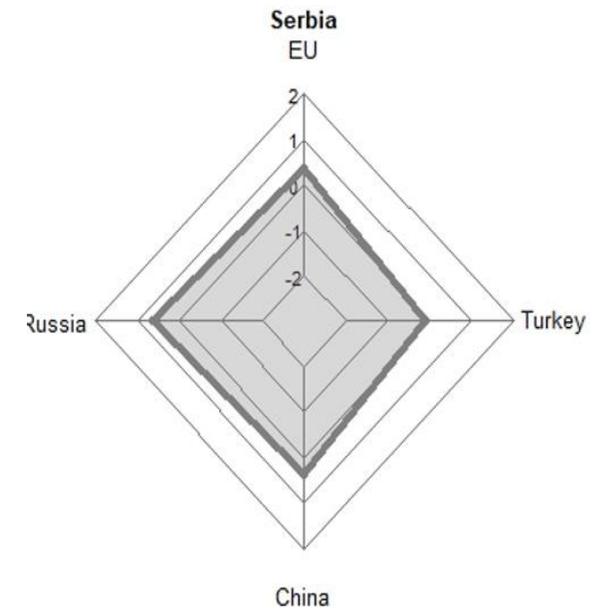
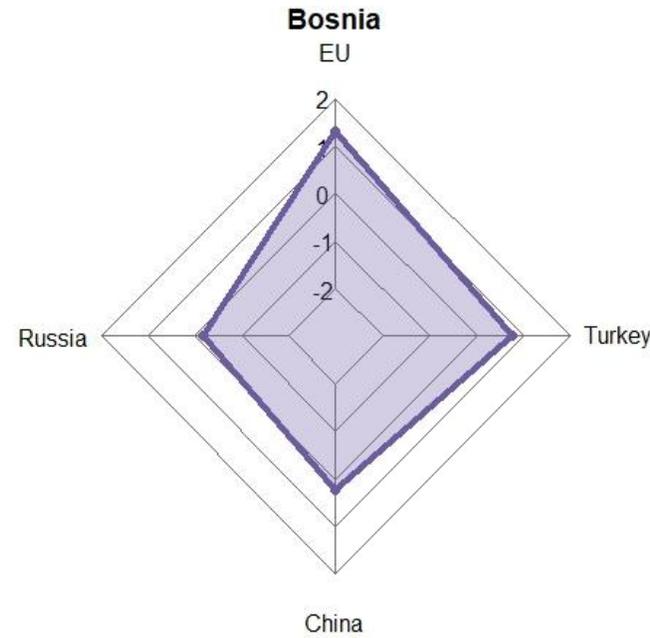
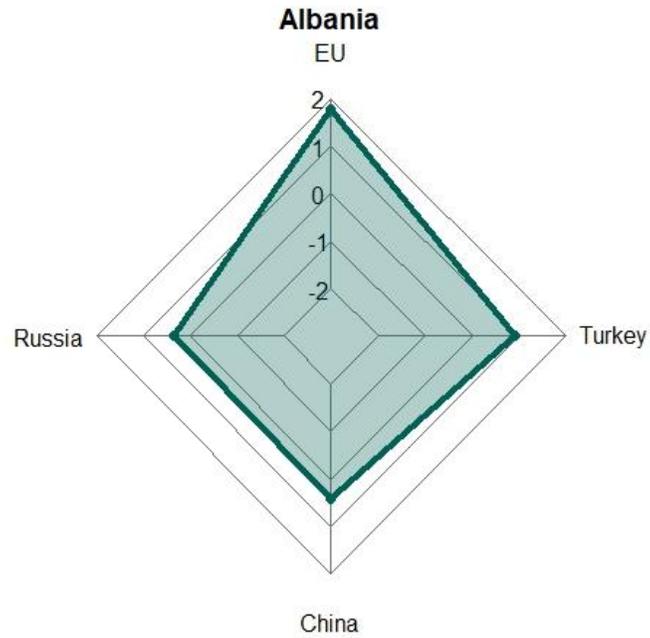
- Vignette survey implemented with Re-Engage partners: Institute of Contemporary History (Serbia), European University Tirana (Albania), and University of Sarajevo (Bosnia and Herzegovina)
- Quota sampling in capitals and secondary cities in Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, and Serbia – 1680 respondents
  - Male and female
  - Age (in the spans **18-29**, **30-54**, **55+**)
  - Education level
- Face-to-face street interviews
- Randomized, designated locations of 600 square metres in the cities
  - Quotas are randomly assigned across the ‘pinpoints’

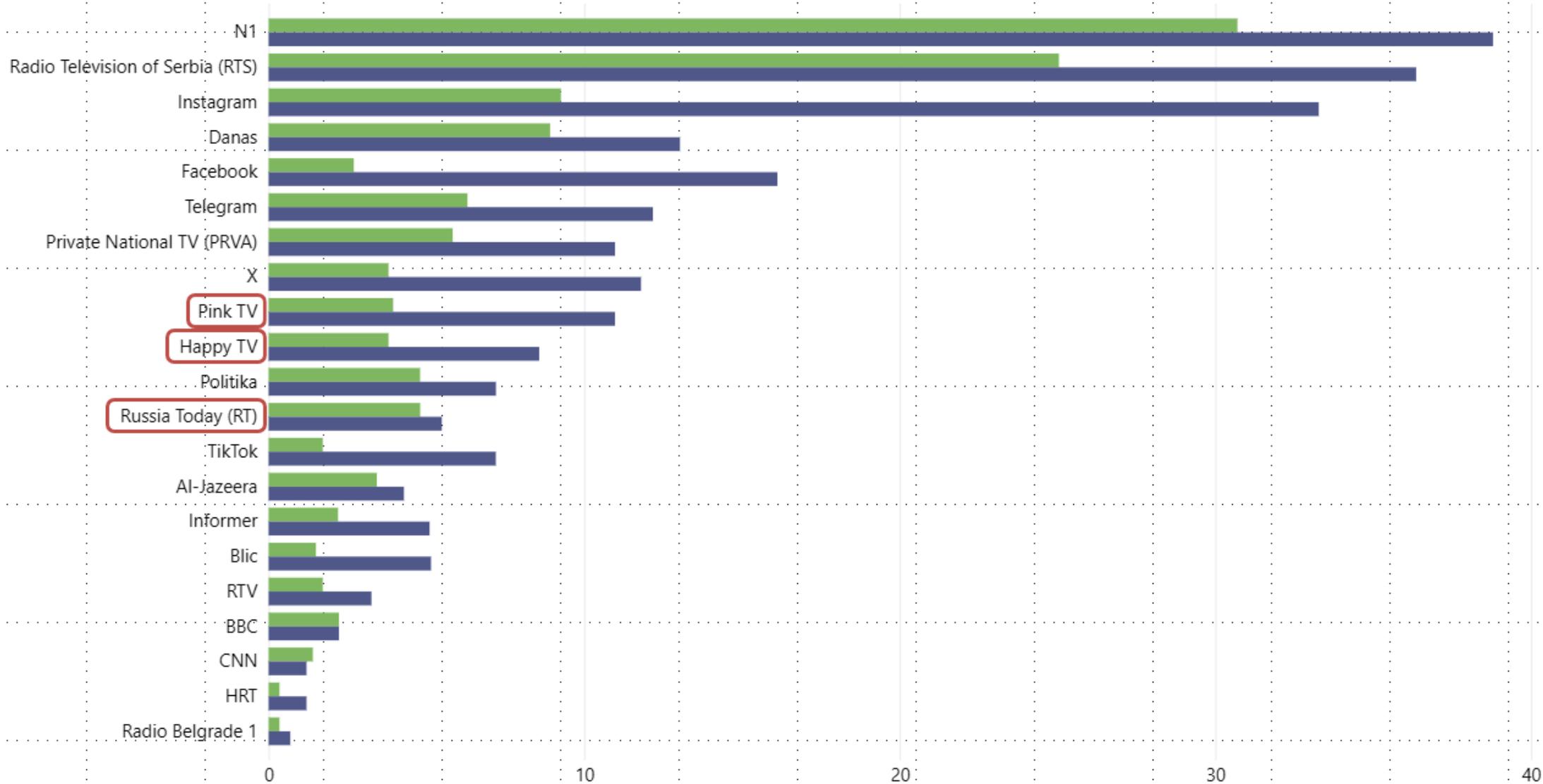
